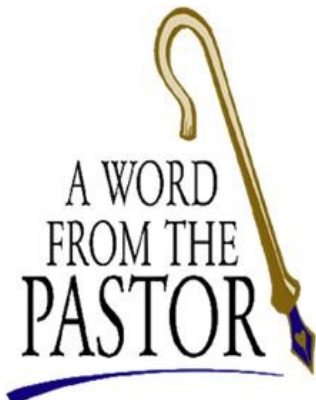
PARISH REGISTRATION is held in the vestibule of the Church after all Masses on the 1st and 3rd weekends of the month. You may also register at the Parish Office on weekdays during business hours.

BAPTISM is usually celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 12:00PM. Please call Mrs. Gauntner at 610-666-0167 for upcoming baptism dates. Parents must attend our Pre-Jordan Class prior to their child's baptism. Our next Pre-Jordan class will be held at 7:00PM on **Wednesday July 25, 2018** in our Parish Center.

MATRIMONY: Couples must make arrangements for matrimony in person with the Pastor at least six months prior to date of their anticipated wedding ceremony. One of the parties must have family registered in the parish at the time the couple comes to make arrangements. Please call the Parish Office for an appointment with Father Wild.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK: Parishioners who are seriously ill, weakened by advanced age, or entering the hospital for surgery are encouraged to request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Homebound sick and elderly may receive Holy Communion in their homes on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish Office to arrange for a home visit or to request an anointing.

My Dear Parishioners,

Last Saturday, Sixteen men were ordained to serve as deacons. I am pleased that Dave Matour, our parishioner was one of those men and has been assigned by Archbishop Chaput to assist me, as pastor, in the pastoral care of St. Teresa of Avila Parish.

The modern-day Permanent Diaconate is a ministry in which deacons do not later become priests. Often confused with the transitional deacons, who are ordained deacons in an interim step toward priesthood, Permanent Deacons are typically married men with families (although single men may be ordained), who have full-time employment in the private sector.

The word *deacon* derives from the Greek *diakonia*, meaning service, indicating that the deacon is called, like Christ, to be servant. Permanent Deacons live the Church's mission of proclaiming God's love and justice, while inspiring others to lives of service and conversion of heart. This involves reaching out to the poor, ministering to the hospitalized and incarcerated, and advocating for those who are marginalized.

As ministers of the altar, Permanent Deacons can baptize, witness marriages, perform funeral and burial services outside of Mass, distribute Holy Communion, proclaim the Gospel and preach the homily.

Permanent Deacons are committed to living as a representation of Christ in their homes, in the Church, on their jobs, in their community, and in the world. Thank you to the dedicated men who serve as a wonderful example of Christ's love at St. Teresa of Avila and beyond.

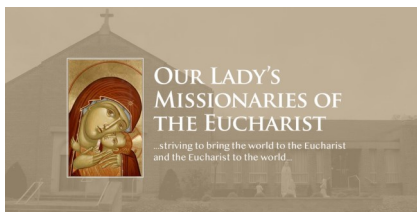

Our Lady's Missionaries of the Eucharist Invite You to Fatima Evening, July 11, 2018 6-8pm

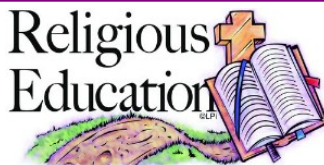

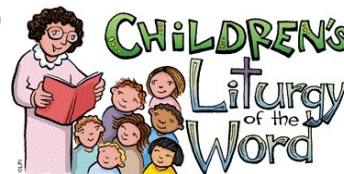
2018-19 PREP REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN
